

Pupil Privacy Notice for parents of younger pupils - Key Information

This notice contains the key information about how and why we collect your child's personal information and what we do with that information. We refer to all academies within the Cabot Learning Federation as the **Academy** in this notice.

The Academy is part of the Cabot Learning Federation (the **CLF**). The CLF operates the Academy and is ultimately responsible for how the Academy handles your personal information.

Personal information is information that identifies your child as an individual and relates to your child. For example, information about how well your child is doing at the Academy and any information that we need to take care of your child. Photographs and videos of your child also count as their personal information.

The full version includes additional points, such as:

- the rights your child has in their information including what decisions you can make about your child's information;
- for how long the Academy retains your child's personal information; and
- our legal bases for using your child's personal information.

Our primary reason for using your child's personal information is to provide him/her with an education.

We set out below examples of the different ways in which we use your child's personal information and where that personal information comes from.

- Admissions forms give us lots of personal information about your child. We get information from you, your child's teachers and other pupils. Your child's old school also gives us information about your child so that we can teach and care for your child.
- Sometimes we get information from your child's doctors and other professionals where we need this to look after your child.
- We may need to report some of your child's information to the government (e.g. the Department for Education). We will need to tell the local authority that your child attends the Academy, if your child leaves the Academy or let them know if we have any concerns about your child's welfare.
- We may use photographs or videos of your child for the Academy's website and social media sites or prospectus to show prospective pupils what we do here and to advertise the Academy. We may continue to use these photographs and videos after your child has left the Academy. In some cases we may ask for your consent for this purpose. If we ask for your consent you may withdraw this at any time.



- Sometimes we use photographs and videos for teaching purposes, for example, to record a drama lesson.
- We use CCTV to make sure the Academy's site is safe. CCTV is not used in private areas such as changing rooms.
- We will keep details of your child's address when they leave so we can send them keep in touch and find out how they are getting on.

The Data Protection Lead is the person responsible at our Academy for managing how we look after personal information. The Data Protection Lead can answer any questions which you may have about how we use your child's personal information.
